## Parent-Young Marine-Commanding Officer Contract

The purpose of this contract is to promote the development of a Young Marine, Young Marine Staff and Parent “team” to assist all Young Marines in achieving the unit’s academic standards. It is the Young Marine’s responsibility to maintain their Grade Point Average (GPA) while in school. The Unit will support the parents by maintaining their high standards for the Young Marine’s GPA. While it is the responsibility of the Young Marines to maintain their GPAs, the parents must remember to be supportive of their Young Marines and encourage them to maintain a positive attitude while in school.

Since helping all children achieve high academic standards is our goal, any student who falls below the unit’s minimum GPA requirement (2.0) or fails any course in school is put on “academic probation.” This means that the student will need to have grade checks done monthly at school until the grades come up. Also, a student could become ineligible for unit deployments, promotions, encampments and schools, if you do not show any improvement.

In addition, failure to comply with the academic or behavioral expectations listed in this contract may result in actions by the Commanding Officer as stated above. In receiving/signing this contract, you agree to all of the requirements in the contract.

**The Wildomar Young Marine Staff will** agree to encourage and support Young Marines’ academics by doing the following:

- Demonstrating care, concern and support for each Young Marine
- Requiring Young Marines to always demonstrate respect for teachers, peers and all other adults.

**As a Parent**, I will encourage and support my child’s learning by doing the following:

- Requiring regular school attendance
- Supporting the school’s guidelines
- Requiring my child to always demonstrate respect for teachers, peers and all other adults at school
- Providing a quiet, well-lit study area
- Establishing a regular time for study
- Attending parent-teacher conferences
- Encouraging students to do their best work
- Setting an example for my child by being a life-long learner myself

**As a Young Marine**, I will demonstrate that I am a trustworthy and responsible student by being an independent learner who is an active participant in my own learning by doing the following:

- Reading, accepting and following the student guidelines of my school
- Striving to do my best in every class, not just the ones I like
- Demonstrating by my actions and words respect for teachers, peers, and other adults.
- Respecting all school property
- Attending school regularly
- Bringing pencils, pens, paper, textbooks, and other necessary learning tools to class.
- Participating in classroom activities and especially by asking questions and seeking additional instruction if needed.
- Cooperating with parents and teachers
- Asking for help when needed
